


COURSE OBJECTIVES



The objective of this qualification is to enable participants to develop an understanding of safety and health and what that means to a business.

With in-depth focus on the things that matter, the NGC covers:

- How to effectively manage health and safety
- The UK's key legal requirements
- How to identify and control common workplace hazards
- How to measure success



UNITS AND ASSESSMENTS

There are two assessments for the NEBOSH General Certificate:

- NG1 will be assessed by a 2-hour written exam consisting of 10 short answer questions and 1 long answer.
- A 3-hour practical risk assessment carried out in the workplace to demonstrate the knowledge learned in elements 5-11.

1-2-1 support will be provided throughout the course to ensure learners complete their exams and pass the course.

The length of time it takes to pass the NEBOSH General Certificate qualification depends on which type of training method you chose.

Online Course: This usually takes around 80 – 120 hours to complete but is flexible and can be worked around you and your commitments. You will have access to the e-learning resources and online tutor support for 12 months from the start of the course date.

Classroom Course: This usually consists of two split weeks (10 days). You'll be expected to travel to a single place of study on specific dates. Alternatively in-house courses are available.

COURSE FUNDING



There are funding options available in the UK for the NEBOSH General Certificate, however access to this funding is dependant on individual circumstances. For example, NEBOSH have teamed up with the Charities Safety Group to help qualify those who work at charities and voluntary sector groups.

If you have served in the armed forces, you can also apply for funding through Ministry of Defence Enhanced Learning Credits. The amount of assistance received will depend on how long you were in the military for, but you can get up to 80% of your course paid for through Ministry of Defence Enhanced Learning Credits. Personal loans and CITB funding are also available for those eligible
